Council Camporee : Jon is running the Council Camporee in 2022. It's running May 13 – 15 and wanted to see if the alumni association is interested in supporting the event. Jon will send the info packet with schedule and session information.

Would we want to run some of the even stations in the morning on May 14th?

- We would just need to provide the bodies to run the stations. The events are planned and equipment provided by the committee.
- 10 stations (all Scoutcraft Type events) with 10 patrols per rotation.
 - Fire building
 - Pioneering
 - Knot Tying
 - First Aid
 - Etc
- Rotating groups will be by similar skill level. Will get 1st – 4th place for each rotation.

Would we want to do the campfire on May 14th?

- Campfire would also include the Council Court of Honor Awards; Silver Beaver, NESA, etc

Sunday May 15th we could do a fundraiser breakfast (8 – 10am)?

- \$5 per person (pancakes, eggs, sausage, juice). The camporee fee doesn't include the breakfast. They will pre-register and we would get a final headcount about a week beforehand.
- If we pass this will probably go to the lodge

Expecting 400 – 600 Scouts. 100 Patrols of 6; open to Webelos (attached to Troops), Troops, and Crews.

Jon needs a commitment by February at the latest.

Treasurer report: report submitted via email

There was a request from Henry Edge to fund his NYLT training course which is in June 2022 for around \$275. It was decided that this should be an item for the 2022 budget planning in January / February.
