Museum report:

We have two boards that are still in the Scoutmaster Lounge that need to be relocated to the museum. The old Evergreen Area Council sign has been relocated to the museum. Pat Smith has donated a small set of Kelecma patches to the museum collection. Thank You PAT! Jon Gross has updated the museum computer with windows 11 and downloaded software for the printer. Still working to get sound and audio from TV to computer. Needs a splinter. Dave Anderson brought in his personal collection of patches for the OA exhibit for Conclave and to Fall Ordeal weekend. Few people at Conclave have donated a few Black Mt. items. Patches & a staff T-shirt. I worked on the file cabinet and found a original copy of a timber topics Sept 1972 regarding the opening of Camp Fire Mt. Kevin the Council Executive stopped by to see the museum. We had a great chat regarding the museum. I have given a request of things to Sean to fix for the museum on Fall Ordeal weekend.
