Haunted Camp – over 500 in attendance. A bunch of folks enjoyed the museum.

Alumni Xmas party — Sat Dec 17, 4-8pm at camp. Sven would like a turkey dinner. Ethan will be there so it can be prepped in Knoll Lodge. Potluck? Side items? Museum Update – last year's attendance 1028, this year so far 2,224. Way more events this year with the museum open. Haunted Camp was the largest attendance in one day (400), Woodbadge day was lowest (12). Dean Evans reached out re calendar for sale. Two were sent and he will donate \$18 to FMSAA. Spare patches for sale. Keep the best quality items and sell others. S2 for sale: gold border Six

Mox Lamonti ghost patch. Worth \$1,500 per Pat Smith. An anonymous person is donating another S2 patch. Two buyers, each for \$2k. Total \$4k for the museum. Over the summer over \$900 has been raised in the sale of duplicate books and patches. That is then put back into the museum. Kevin Nichols to get signed photo of Secretary Gates. Already have President Ford. Permanent shelving in storage unit is a go. Jason Walter will install them. We still have a storage problem. Anticipate 12 more storage bins to be added. Currently have 62 full bins. Dec 3 final measurements. Need a couple of days to accomplish these tasks. Draft museum schedule to Sven for approval. No answer yet received. Cabinets are still needed. Two alumni have been contacted for building custom cabinets funded by Mr. McKinley. We have received quotes. Plan is for two cabinets. Installation planned for first quarter of next year. One of the Kelcema boards from the potlatch room as been removed. A big one still needs to be removed. Relocate to new SM lounge by the first aid station. Current issues on Ed's new phone reading CCs for payments. Need new slider or chip reader or tap. Jacob Burdette would donate a square reader. It does tap and chip reads. Per Jacob – new Iphones have tap technology.

Ed has a personal mannequin in his room. JoLynn has snorted. Bought for \$30 at JC Penny and used for personal seasonal displays.
